www.rollcall.com: *Roll Call* is one of two newspapers that specialize in covering Capitol Hill. During election years, its coverage of primaries and elections gives inside details.

www.hillnews.com: *The Hill* is the other Capitol Hill newspaper. Although somewhat less well-known than *Roll Call*, *The Hill* provides excellent inside views.
